



DESCRIPTION

The Outpost is an intensive, biblically grounded, 9-month gap year program running from September through May. Designed for young adults ages 18–23, the program focuses on discipleship, spiritual formation, and leadership development. Participants are equipped for a lifestyle of ministry through immersive, hands-on experience and intentional mentoring.

Utilizing Victory Bible Camp as a training ground, Outpost participants gain hands-on experience within the camp's ministry. Posties receive foundational teaching in Bible and theology, while also developing life skills and exploring personal growth. The 9-month program allows for deeper immersion into various aspects of ministry as well as intentional accountability and guidance for every student.

MISSION

The Outpost exists to train, develop and launch leaders using a biblically based discipleship model that emphasizes both knowing and doing as a measure of success.

VISION

To see young Christians, deepen their relationship with God and gain a clearer understanding of how they are uniquely equipped by God to live out a life of ministry.

VALUES

- **Biblical Knowledge** – Students are encouraged to study, memorize, and apply God's Word to everyday life, learning to live obediently and faithfully.
- **Community Fellowship** – Students actively engage in life together, building relationships with peers, Victory staff, and the surrounding Glacier View community.
- **Servant Leadership** – Through teaching and hands-on experience, students are trained to lead with humility and purpose, modeling Christ-like leadership.
- **Personal Development** – Students will take a few personality and strengths assessments, but more importantly, they will begin by learning who God is and, through that lens, discover how He uniquely created them to live in community and purpose.

EXPECTATIONS

Each Outpost participant will:

- Uphold Victory Ministries' mission, vision and values as well as regulate their personal lives in a godly manner, portraying a Biblical lifestyle and holding to the Outpost Behavior Guidelines.
- Be expected to participate and attend all classes as well as complete any homework or assignments needing to be completed outside of class.
- Be accountable to the Outpost leadership team as well as those put in authority over them departmentally or corporately. (Rom. 13.1)
- Be responsible for weekend department/retreat duties/store duties as scheduled along with completing other work projects assigned throughout the year.
- Respect those they live and work with, portraying a servant like attitude, applying a Matthew 18 method when conflict arises.
- Learn/build life skills needed for independent living.

Weekly breakdown:

Every Tuesday and Wednesday, students will participate in Outpost's **Core Classes** ranging from Bible courses and book studies to ministry and personal development classes. Some evenings are free, though students may need to use this time for homework or projects. Special **Module Courses** will also be included several times throughout the semester with guest teachers and assorted topics.

CORE CLASS SAMPLER:

Biblical Survey - Putting the events of the Bible in chronological order and characters in context.

Foundations – What are the basic beliefs of Christianity? How does the Bible instruct us to live? A beginner's look at theology and doctrine.

Leadership and Discipleship – What are the qualifications of a leader? Is God really asking me to lead? A deeper look into true Biblical leadership.

Personal Development - Discovering God's design for each individual: a look at Spiritual Gifts, personality types, behavior styles and more.

Discipleship & Community - Looking at what it means to be a disciple and how to live out Matthew 28:19-20 today.

Thursdays will vary on a weekly basis between **Life Skills** classes, **Ministry Visits** and retreat duties, depending on the overall camp operations schedule.

Friday through Sunday are committed to hands-on ministry experience while we host guest groups at camp. Students will be scheduled for weekend **Retreat Duties**, as well as weekly housekeeping responsibilities, shifts in the gift shop, and other camp operations.

Mondays will be the regularly scheduled day off (unless otherwise required).

Cost:

The total cost for the 2026–2027 Outpost program is \$3,200 (\$1,600 per semester). This includes room and board. Students are responsible for personal clothing and basic supplies, and are encouraged to budget accordingly.
